

1. action plan	a list of tasks to be completed as part of a project
2. computer aided design (CAD)	an automated system for the design, drafting and display of graphic information
3. computer aided manufacturing (CAM)	a computer program that makes manufacturing data from CAD drawings to automate the manufacture of a product by a computer-controlled machine
4. computer numerical control (CNC)	the computer control of machine tools for the purpose of repetitively manufacturing complex parts for a product
5. efficiency	ratio of output or work done to energy used of input supplied
6. lathe	a machine used for cutting and working wood or metal that spins the material against a cutting tool
7. occupational overuse syndrome (OOS)	a range of conditions, including injury to, or discomfort or pain in muscles or soft tissue
8. prototype	the preliminary version of a product or design from which other versions are developed
9. sustainable	causing little or no damage to the environment or not using finite resources and therefore able to continue for a long time
10. tungsten lamp	a lamp in which light is produced by a tungsten filament heated by an electric current
