1. blood alcohol concentration (BAC)	the concentration of alcohol in a person's blood, measure in g/100mL
2. braking distance	the distance travelled between when a driver applies the brakes and when the vehicle stops completely
3. fatality	an accident resulting in death, or a person who dies in an accident
4. reaction distance	the distance travelled during a driver's reaction time
5. reaction time	the time between when a driver senses that he needs and when he applies the brakes
6. standard drink	a drink that contains 10 grams of alcohol
7. stopping distance	the distance travelled between when the driver senses that he needs to stop and when the vehicle stops completely, equal to the sum of the reaction distance and braking distance
